[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING
PLAINTIFF'S UNOPPOSED MOTION
FOR PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF
CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT

(CLERK'S ACTION REQUIRED)

This matter came before the Court on Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement ("Plaintiff's Motion"). The Court considered the following:

1. Plaintiff's Motion;
2. The Declaration of Ari Robbins Greene in support of Plaintiff's Motion and Exhibits attached thereto, including the Settlement Agreement and the Proposed Notice to the Class; and
3. The files and records herein.

Having fully considered the matter the Motion is hereby **GRANTED**. It is further **ORDERED** that:

1. The parties' settlement is granted preliminary approval as it meets the criteria for preliminary settlement approval, appears to be the product of arm's length and informed negotiations, and appears to be fair, adequate, and reasonable to the Class.

1 2. The Court approves, as to form, content, and method of delivery, the Notice of Class
2 Action Settlement, attached as Exhibit A to the Settlement Agreement (“Class Notice”).

3 Class Counsel must also ensure that any Class Member who indicates a desire or intent
4 to attend the Final Approval Hearing is provided with full hearing information to
5 attend. -TVF

6 7. 3. The Court appoints Atticus Administration, LLC as the Settlement Administrator.

8 4. The Court provisionally certifies the following settlement class:

9 a. 10. All individuals employed by any restaurants or entities owned by and/or
11 11. operated by Defendant in Washington state in positions paid on an hourly basis
12 12. at any time on or after February 20, 2022 up to and including the date of the
13 13. Court's preliminary approval of the settlement.

14 5. 15. Class members will be bound by the terms of the Settlement Agreement unless they
15 16. submit a timely Request for Exclusion (opt out) within 30 days after the mailing of the
16 17. Class Notice by the Settlement Administrator.

17 6. 18. The Court orders the following schedule of dates for further proceedings:

	Defendant to fund Settlement	Within 10 days after Settlement Effective Date.
	Settlement Administrator to issue checks for Individual Class Payments, the Administration expenses Payment, the Class Counsel Fees Payment, the Class Counsel Litigation Expenses Payment, and the Class Representative Service Payment.	Within 14 days after Defendant funds the Gross Settlement Amount.
